

Club Grant Funding Policy

The following policy was approved in October 2013.

Annually the Shooting Federation of Nova Scotia will budget an amount for Grant Funding. Any unused portion of the Grant Fund will be carried over to the Grant Fund in the subsequent year.

The Shooting Federation Nova Scotia will consider grants to affiliated clubs for the following reasons:

1. Hosting an open Club or Provincial Match
2. Range Improvements
3. New Equipment
4. Training
5. Coaching

Applicants must submit an application by the cut off date of May 1 of the project year.

Applications must include:

1. Purpose of Grant including details of projected expenses and revenues
2. Number of expected participants (if applicable) or club members benefiting
3. Amount requested

Criteria for distribution will be:

1. No one application will receive more than 50% of available grant funds.
2. No application will receive more than 50% of net project costs.
3. No club will receive more than one grant in a fiscal year.
4. Club matches will receive a maximum grant of \$50.00.

Grant requests received will be considered by the Shooting Federation of Nova Scotia at its first Council meeting following the cut off date. Clubs will be advised of the amount of funding approved. Cheques for approved grants will be made payable to the requesting club and mailed upon receipt by the Shooting Federation of paid receipts supporting the approved application.
